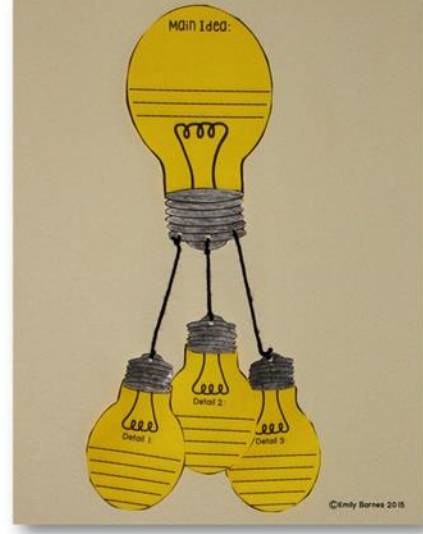
Directions: Students make pockets, and sort the sentences. On the blank ones they will need to write their own sentence that come up with.
